President Bob Cohn informs the membership that there will be enforcement of Article

VI, Section 2

of the Brown Deer Golf Club By-Laws which states as follows:

*The Membership and Handicap Committees shall compile and post a list of all members who have not recorded a minimum of ten (10) scores on his handicap card by August 1. Any member not recording ten (10) scores during the current year will, upon notification, be dropped from the membership of the Club. The member may appeal to the Membership at the next Club meeting. Special circumstances to exempt any member from this rule must be submitted to the current President. Each special circumstance will be reviewed by the current and the two (2) immediate past Presidents on a case-by-case basis.*

We currently have 61 members without the required 10 scores including 27 members with less than 5.
