

Brown Deer Golf Club  
Wednesday, September 4, 2013

Meeting called to order by President Robert Cohn.

Brown Deer golf Course grounds superintendent Tim Wegner provided a season ending report on course conditions. Of special note:

- Fear of Emerald Ash Borer situation has prompted removal of some trees with others at risk. Holes being watched carefully are the trees on Holes #17 (right side), #9 (right side), Hole #18 (right side) and especially Hole #1 (right side).
- Looking into dogs for geese control this fall.
- All sprinkler heads should be replaced by the middle of the 2014 season with new yardage markers attached.
- Aerification on Brown Deer greens will be done on September 30 & October 1. Nine holes will be available for play each day.

Scott Evans, PGA reported the following:

- The Chicago Open Qualifier was held on September 3 at the Brown Deer Golf Course.
- The 2013 Brown Deer "Big Brownie" will be held on Saturday, October 26 and big brownies (without nuts) will be served.
- The winner of the raffle following the 6:00pm clinic was Russ Hinz. Russ won a TaylorMade Rocketballz #5 Hybrid golf club.

Secretary Russ Hinz reported the following:

- Club Championship, Cup Matches and Senior Cup Match brackets have been updated on the BDGC web site.
- The 2013 NIMAGA will contested at Evergreen GC on Saturday, September 21.

President Bob Cohn reported the following:

- Vice President Mike Kruck has had recent back surgery. That, coupled with family health issues, have caused Mike to play minimal golf this season. Mike will not run for the 2014 BDGC Vice Presidency.
- The BDGC Bill Eckhardt Two Man Best Ball had 86 participants and that gift cards were available for the winners along with gift cards from the BDGC Member / Guest event.
- BDGC elections for 2013 Club officers will be held at the October Club meeting.

Steve Boehme reported that the deadline date of September 13th for the Windup will be strictly adhered to as tee times must be released to the public.

Andy Osowski, 2nd Team Captain reported that the final 2nd Team competition will be held on September 15. Brown Deer is in first place with an 18 point lead over 2nd place Currie. Volunteers are needed for spotting and to contact Andy as soon as possible.

Bruce Myslis reported that the final 2013 Summer tour event will be held on Saturday, September 14.

Jack Kreger reported that the Two Man Match Medal Championship will be completed by September 25.

Bill Joy reported that the 2013 BDGC Fall Tour is seeking participants and that those interested in participating should contact him.

Rich Sell reported that the 2013 BDGC Awards Banquet will be held on Saturday, October 26. The cost will be \$27 per person. Rich could use donated door prizes.

A brief discussion followed with regards to Brown Deer Golf Club By-Law Rule 10. The rule stipulates that a BDGC member must have ten posted scores by October 31 and that if the member has less than ten posted scores by August 1, notification of the situation is to go to that member with encouragement to post the required scores.
